**204-1.01 Time of Deposit.**—All courts or court officials collecting costs under the assessment provisions of Chapter 69-111, Laws of Florida, for establishment of a Florida Police Academy shall, not later than the fortieth day after the end of each calendar month, deposit all such costs collected during that calendar month in the State Treasury.

**204-1.02 Manner of Deposit.**—All such deposits shall be made with the State Treasurer to the credit of the general revenue fund, Florida Police Academy, and shall be accompanied by a transmittal slip in such form as may be prescribed by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement.
